- 2. When my soul does not long for times of rich fellowship in God's word or in prayer I have left my first love. *"And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy soul" (Mark 12:30)*
- 3. When my thoughts during leisure moments do not reflect upon the Lord, I have left my first love. *"And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy mind" (Mark 12:30)*
- 4. When I claim to be only human and when I basely give in to those things which I know displease the Lord, I have left my first love. "And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy strength..." (Mark 12:30) "If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love..." (John 15:10). "If you love me, keep my command-ments" (John 14:15)
- 5. When I do not willingly and cheerfully give to God's work or to the needs of others, I have left my first love. "But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion for him, how dwelleth the love of God in Him?" (I John 3:17)
- 6. When I cease to treat every Christian as I would the Lord, I have left my first love. *"Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me" (Matt. 25:40). "A new commandment I give unto you, that ye love one another; as I have loved you..." (John 13:34)*
