#### LIGHT AND INFLUENCE

"This is the message we have heard from Him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with Him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin" (I John 1:5-7)

Being lights in the world results from following the example of Jesus and walking in His light. Remember the first words that God spoke in Genesis: "Let there be light" (1:3). By the time we get to the end of Scripture, we find that God is the light in heaven (Rev. 22:5). Light bookends all of Scripture, with God Himself being the source. This is no surprise, since God dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see (I Tim. 6:16). God is light!

Now focus for a moment on the fact that Jesus came into this world as light. "I am the light of the world" (John 8:12). It is in this light that Christians are called upon to be lights in this world. We are imitating the ultimate Light, our Lord Jesus Christ, in whose image we are reborn. This then is our task: "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven". (Mt. 5:14-16)

May God help us to be what He has called us to be, "for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light" (Eph. 5:8).

Walk in the light as He is in the light... and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. I Jn 1:7
